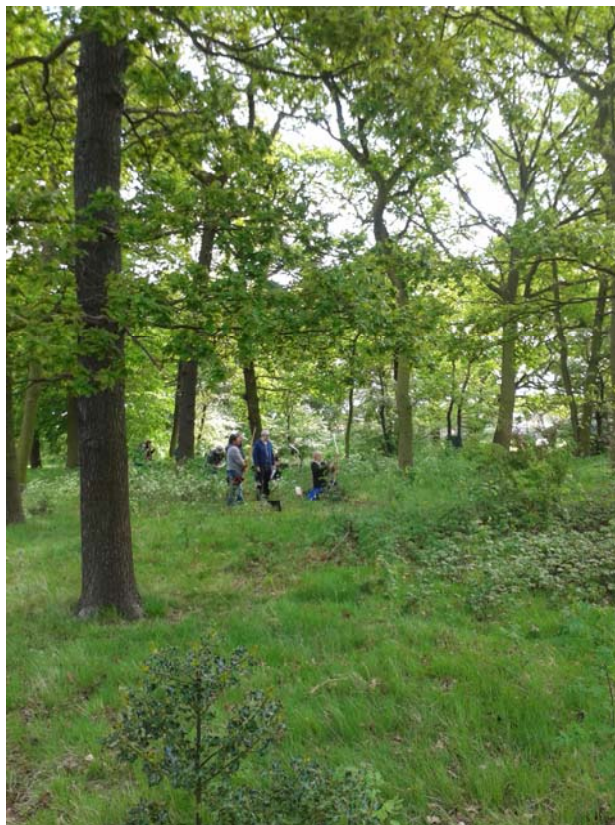

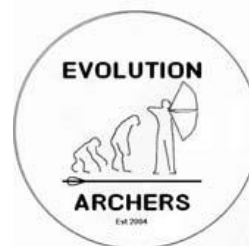

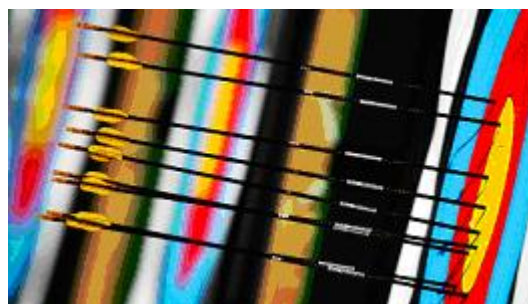

### **Lamorbey Park Archers, Crecy Clout - 24 May**

A group of Bromley's archers journeyed to Eltham College for the annual celebration of the Battle of Crecy. LPA's clout compound enclosed the expected knight on horseback and his attendant knights. Some rain was forecast but the day started sunny.

Scoring this year was only slightly less generous but easier for the scribes. Arrows hitting a shield or sword on the ground in the outer ring scored 3 points (nothing for the grass), knight in the outer compound 7 points, inner ring which surrounded the mounted knight 5 points, knight within the inner ring 9 points and the man himself and his horse 12 points. Five and a half dozen were shot for scoring and a final massed volley of three arrows from 100 yards.

Those shooting 180 yards were separated from everyone else due to the challenging distance; 140 and 120 yards were combined and smaller juniors shot 100 yards. Prizes were split by gender. With the wind gusting and swirling archers were challenged all day. Everyone could hear in the distance when any of the knights were hit but anything on the ground remained a mystery till we went to collect. Much disappointment abounded if arrows ended up in the outer compound and just missed the ground accoutrements. Much joy if an arrow hit anything solid! The raven on the castle battlements remained safe throughout the day although it did slip of its perch a few times.

There was a break for refreshments halfway through and some of our number expected catering at that stage. No Steve! You're supposed to bring your own halftime snacks. Once shooting had finished a fantastic lunch appeared and so did the rain, but it didn't last long. With various shelters covering some of the better prepared, everyone ate and waited for the raffle.
