5 May 2013

The Battle of Crécy took place on 26 August 1346 and was part of the Hundred Years' War saga. Obviously the English army won or we wouldn't be celebrating it every year at Lamorbey Park Archers' Eltham College battlefield.

The morning of 5 May dawned bright. The forecast was good and Bromley Archery Club had a large contingent of archers ready to do battle. How could we possibly lose!

The clout compound was smaller this year and a series of spikes had been placed to stop the French advance on the English line. However, the knight on horseback was still very much in evidence brandishing his sword, along with his menacing attendants standing around him. On the ground were shields and various other accoutrements to add to the English archers' scores if they hit them.



Due to the popularity of the shoot, the number of ends was extended from three dozen to five dozen this year. The final end was a volley of three arrows per archer from 100 yards.

The knight on horseback got a battering. He was hit a number of times in the head and other places, and the horse looked decidedly annoyed at being stuck so many times. Ben Newman was noted to have hit the knight and his horse the most number of times. No prizes for that but a claim to fame nonetheless.

There was a brand new prize this year for which archers competed during the first five ends. It was to shoot an arrow closest to the mounted knight's heart. Competition was fierce but at the end of day our own Alison Steward won the Challis cup, a glass cup handmade by our host Ray Tribe. Very well done to Alison and thanks to Ray.

After the battle and a good lunch, juniors competed at the rotary shield stand. A number of shields whirled round on mechanised arms and the archers tried to hit them with their arrows. Some of them made it look easy. The motor in the centre got a bit of beating as well!





MedSocs, Belmont House Roving Marks - 24 March

Roving marks are challenging at the best of times due to the variable distances but with frozen body parts and a vicious crosswind, arrows were blown off course and ended up in interesting and unplanned places. In spite of the plummeting temperatures, everyone's spirits remained buoyant with the warm and jovial atmosphere among the assembled archers. From the Bromley party our very own **Roy Walker** won **First** equal place for the **heavy bows** along with four other archers.
